ORNL FCU SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Applications are being accepted through the ORNL FCU Scholarship Program for the 2025–2026 school year. A minimum of three (3) scholarships are awarded each school year to deserving students/members that excel in education and social merit: One (1) B.A. Candler Scholarship, one (1) John McKittrick Scholarship, and one (1) David Watkins Scholarship.

The \$1,000 scholarships can be used for tuition, books, or other school related expenses. Only members of ORNL FCU and members of their families who are enrolled or plan to enroll in the University of Tennessee at Knoxville and are pursuing a 4-year degree are eligible to compete for the scholarship. All applicants must complete a FAFSA Form for federal student aid coded for the University of Tennessee.

The FAFSA must be filed by February 1, 2025.

Members can find information about the scholarship and application process at ornlfcu.com at the bottom of the Community page, under the About tab. Applicants have the opportunity to submit their application online or download the form to print and submit via mail or email. The ORNL FCU Scholarship application must be received no later than March 1, 2025.

Applicants are selected by the UT General Scholarship Committee and will be notified directly by the University of Tennessee Financial Aid Office by early June.

As you file your taxes this year, keep in mind that the fastest, easiest, and most secure way to receive your tax return is through direct deposit! Be sure to double, triple, even quadruple check both your account and routing number before you file. Every ORNL FCU account has the same routing number: **264281416.**

HOW DO I FIND MY ACCOUNT NUMBER?

There are two places to easily find your full account number. One option is to look at the bottom of your personal checks! The account number is the **second set of numbers.** You can also log in to Online or Mobile Banking and navigate to the account you would like to deposit your return to. Then, select *Show Details* and click or



tap on the eye icon to reveal your full account number.
