

Community Shred Day events are free to all Credit Union members and the public. Bring any unwanted paper documents, especially ones containing personal information, to one of the event locations to have the materials safely and securely destroyed at no charge. Due to the limited amount of space available for shredding per truck, each vehicle is permitted to shred up to three boxes\* of paper.



Each year, Dogwood Arts brings large-scale sculptures to our city streets and spaces through its *Art in Public Places* program. The outdoor sculpture exhibition rotates annually and pieces are installed throughout Knoxville, Oak Ridge, Alcoa, and Maryville. This past spring, *Art in Public Places* expanded to include a new sculpture site along South Knoxville's Waterfront District and three new sculpture sites along the Maryville-Alcoa Greenway in Blount County.

Dogwood Arts began *Art in Public Places* to not only celebrate large-scale art, but the natural beauty of East Tennessee. Since 2007, the program has curated and installed over 260 works of art. As presenting sponsors of Dogwood Arts, ORNL Federal Credit Union is proud to support the organization's mission to promote the arts in our community.

ORNL FCU has two sculptures in the 2024-2025 *Art in Public Places* exhibition. The Oak Ridge Branch is home to Brian Ferriby's *Oak Leaves*, and Corrina Mensoff's *Division of Two III* is installed at the Northshore Branch.
